Scope and Contents

This collection was acquired over many years by gift and purchase from a number of sources. It is a miscellaneous collection of 1.5 linear ft. of materials relating to railroads in the North Country. Included in the collection are the following materials, dating from 1843-2007: stock certificates from railroads in the original New York Central system, photos, timetables, and business papers and ledgers of railroad companies.
